ROUTE 10

Virginia Beach, Norfolk, Suffolk, Smithfield, Surry Court House, Petersburg, Blackstone, Nottoway, Farmville, Appomattox, Lynchburg, Bedford, Roanoke, Salem, Christiansburg, Dublin, Pulaski, Wytheville, Marion, Abingdon, Bristol, Gate City, Stickleysville, Pennington Gap, Ben Hur, Jonesville, Cumberland Gap to the Kentucky line.

101—Virginia Beach to east limits of Fort Story, and from 4.0 miles west of the west limits of Fort Story to 3.3 miles west.

102—Moccasin Gap to Tennessee line.

103—Suffolk to North Carolina line.

104—Appomattox Station, Surrender Grounds, Vera, thence 10.2 miles toward Buckingham Court House.

105—Old Glade Springs to 4 miles north of Saltville and from 5.1 miles south of Liberty via Liberty to Intersection Route 11 about 2.8 miles west of Tazewell, thence along Route 11 to Tazewell and west to West Virginia line.

106—5.0 Miles south of Abingdon, Greendale, Hansonville, Bolton to connect with Route 11 near Dickensonville.

107—Cumberland Gap to Tennessee line.

108—Smithfield to Isle of Wight Court House, and from 11.4 miles north of Route 10 via Walters to Intersection Route 12 about 1.5 miles east of Franklin, thence west along Route 12 to Franklin and south to North Carolina line.

109—Dublin, 17 miles toward Pearisburg via Poplar Hill.

1010—Jonesville, 2 miles toward Blackwater.

1011—Petersburg-Hopewell.

1012—Intersection Route 10 via Kempsville to Princess Anne Court House.

ROUTE 11

0.9 mile west of Bluefield to Bluefield, Burks Garden Siding, via Peery Place, Tazewell, J. A. Crockett's Store, via River Route to Claypoole Hill, Indian Creek route, Rosedale, Lebanon, via Cooper's Creek Route, Old Court House, St. Paul, Coeburn, Norton, Big Stone Gap, to connect with Route 10 at Witt's Store.

111—Claypoole Hill, Raven, Grundy.

112—0.3 Mile south Lebanon—Hansonville.

113—St. Paul—Dante.

114—Coeburn, Clintwood, Fremont, Moss to Haysi.

1141—Intersection with Route 114 near Clintwood, to the Kentucky State line at Pound Gap.

115—Appalachia to Kentucky State line.

116—From Intersection with Route 11 via Natural Tunnel, to intersect Route 10 near Clinchport.

118—Intersection Route 11 near Rosedale to 0.6 mile west of Honaker and from 2.0 miles west of Honaker to Council.

119—Pound toward Wise Court House, 2 miles.

ROUTE 12

Suffolk, Carrsville, Franklin, Courtland, Emporia, Lawrenceville, South Hill, Chase City, Halifax, Danville, Martinsville, Stuart, Hillsville, Galax, Independence, Mouth of Wilson, Troutville, Comers Creek Valley to Rye Valley, along Valley of South Fork of Holston River, near Friendship, near Damascus, to intersect Route 10 east of Abingdon.

121—See 108.

122—Intersection Route 12 at Edgerton to intersect Route 31 near Nottoway River.

123—Mouth of Wilson to North Carolina line.

124—See 201.

125—Graham Bridge, Cedarville to Meadow View.

ROUTE 13

Calleo to Totusky Bridge, Warsaw, Tappahannock, Bray's Fork, Richmond, Midlothian, Powhatan, Cumberland Court House and from 11 miles east of Route 32 at or near Sprouses Corner via Buckingham, thence 5 miles west and from 11 miles east of Amherst via Amherst thence 8.4 miles west, and from Buena Vista to intersect Route 14 near McCormicks Gate.

131—St. Stephens Church to King and Queen Court House.

132—At or near Tobaccoville, via Marven, to 1.2 miles north of Amelia.

133—Cumberland Court House to Farmville.

ROUTE 14

North Carolina Line, Danville, Chatham, Gretna, or western side of Southern Railway to Altavista, Lynchburg, Balcony Falls, Natural Bridge Station, Stone House, point near McCormick's Gate, Lexington, Clifton Forge, Covington to the West Virginia line near White Sulphur.

141—Intersection with Route 14, at Natural Bridge Station to Natural Bridge.

142—See 17.

143—Crows, south to the West Virginia line.

144—Danville to North Carolina line toward Yanceyville.

ROUTE 15

North Carolina line, Hillsville, to Route 10 east of Wytheville.

ROUTE 16

Intersection Route 32 near Madison Mills, Madison to intersection with Route 37 near Sperryville.

ROUTE 17

Gordonsville, Standardsville, Elkton, Harrisonburg, Moscow, Craigsville, Goshen, Millboro, thence 5.76 miles south, and from 2.63 miles north of Longdale to intersect Route 14 near Longdale, thence along Route 14 to Clifton Forge, thence south via Eagle Rock and Fincastle to intersect Route 33 near Troutville.

171—Intersection Route 17 near Christians to Staunton.

172—See 338.

ROUTE 18

Afton, Lovingsston, Colleen, point near Claypoole, Clifford, Amherst, Lynchburg, Brookneal, Halifax, South Boston, to the North Carolina line.

181—Intersection Route 18 near Martins Store, to Nelly's Ford.

ROUTE 19

Richmond, Goochland, to intersect Route 32 at Dixie. Thence south to Fork Union and from 1.0 mile west of Fork Union 1.0 mile west.

ROUTE 20

Richmond, Amelia to intersect Route 10 at a point near Burkeville, thence along Route 10 to Burkeville, thence west to intersect Route 32 about 3.4 miles north of Keysville, to Keysville, Charlotte and Brookneal, thence 2 miles toward Gretna.

201—1.55 miles north of Victoria via Victoria, Lunenburg, thence south to Chase City, thence along Route 12 to Boydton and from Boydton to intersect Route 32 about 0.7 mile north Clarksville.

ROUTE 21—LEE HIGHWAY:

Key Bridge to Fairfax, Gainesville, Warrenton, Massie's Corner, Sperryville, Luray to New Market.

ROUTE 22

Salem, Catawba, New Castle, West Virginia line.

221—Intersection Route 22, to Catawba Sanatorium.

ROUTE 23

North Carolina line, Stuart, Floyd, Christiansburg, Blacksburg, Pearisburg, Narrows to the West Virginia line.

231—Intersection Route 23 at Rich Creek, to West Virginia line at Peterstown.

232—Intersection Route 33, 0.4 mile south Roanoke, to Floyd, thence 3.6 miles toward Hillsville.

ROUTE 24

Intersection Route 35 near Petersburg, Carson, Emporia to the North Carolina line.

ROUTE 25

Intersection Route 31 at Potomac Yards, Chain Bridge, Vienna to Fairfax.

251—Intersection Route 25 at Tyson's Corner, 2.6 miles west, and from Leesburg via Purcellville and Berryville to intersect Route 36 at Millwood, thence south 2 miles toward Front Royal and from 3.8 miles north of Luray via Luray and Stanley to intersect Route 17 near Elkton and from 8.0 miles east of Greenville to intersect Route 33 near Greenville, thence north along Route 33 about 2.0 miles thence west 4.0 miles.

ROUTE 26

West Virginia line to a point near Rocky Gap, Bland C. H., Wytheville, Independence, to the North Carolina line.

ROUTE 27

Norfolk, Berkeley, Great Bridge, Hickory, North Carolina line.

ROUTE 28

Intersection Route 21 at Centreville, via Manassas, to Intersection Route 21 near New Baltimore, and thence along Route 21 to Warrenton, and from Rixeyville to Culpeper, and from 6.5 miles north of Madison to Madison and from 1.5 miles north of Shelby via Shelby to Ruckersville, and from 13.6 miles north of Charlottesville via Charlottesville, to intersect Route 18 three miles north of Mindus.

ROUTE 29

Gloucester Point, Gloucester C. H. to Intersection of Route 30.

291—Gloucester C. H. to Intersection Route 38 about 2.1 miles west of Mathews C. H.

ROUTE 30

From Bridge at Urbanna to intersect Route 38 near Cooks Corner, Saluda, West Point, King William C. H., to Intersection of Route 13, near Sharon Church.

ROUTE 31

Washington, Dumfries, Stafford C. H., Fredericksburg, Thomas' Store, Solomons, Richmond, Petersburg, Dinwiddie, South Hill to the North Carolina line.

Note—The section from South Hill to the North Carolina line not to be maintained or constructed until bridge tolls are abolished.

311—Intersection Route 38, Bowling Green, Hanover to Ashland. To be taken over by State for maintenance until May 1, 1926, only unless the Highway Commission deem it necessary to maintain said road longer.

3111—Intersection Route 311 to Hanover Court House.

312—Intersection Route 31 at Thomas' Store, Spotsylvania C. H., Coatesville, to intersect Route 31 near Gum Tree.

313—Chesterfield C. H., via Centralia, 5.5 miles toward Route 31.

314—Intersection Route 31 to Mt. Vernon.

315—Intersection Route 31 near Woodridge to Occoquan.

ROUTE 32

Maryland line, Leesburg, Aldie, Middleburg, Plains, Warrenton, Remington, Culpeper, Orange, Gordonsville, at or near Palmyra, Dixie, thence along Route 13 to Fork Union, point near Carysbrook, Breomo, Dillwyn, Farmville, to a point about 3.4 miles north of Keysville, thence along Route 20 to Keysville, Wylliesburg, Red Oak, Clarksville to North Carolina line.

321—See 41.

322—See 13.

323—Intersection Route 32 near Keysville to Lunenburg, thence along Route 201 to Victoria, Kenbridge to Blackstone.

324—See 201.

325—See 251.

326—Intersection of Route 32 to Palmyra.

327—Made 314 which was abandoned and then combined with 38.

ROUTE 33

West Virginia line, Winchester, Harrisonburg, Staunton, Lexington, Natural Bridge, Buchanan, Roanoke, Rocky Mount, Martinsville, Ridgeway, to North Carolina line.

331—Woodstock, Calvary, West Virginia line.

332—Intersection Route 33 about 1.8 miles north of Lacy Springs Post Office 13 miles toward Brocks Gap.

333—Harrisonburg, 14 miles toward Rawley Springs.

334—See 251.

335—Rocky Mount, 14.8 miles toward Bedford, and from Bedford, 15.3 miles toward Rocky Mount.

336—Mt. Jackson to 8.2 miles toward Orkney Springs.

337—Ridgeway to the North Carolina line.

338—Intersection Route 33, about 1.25 miles north of Lexington, through Goshen Pass, Goshen, Millboro, Warm Springs to Covington.

ROUTE 34

Maryland line, Accomac, Eastville to Cape Charles.

341—Intersection Route 34 near Alms House to Parkley.

342—Tasley, through town of Onancock.

343—Intersection Route 34, 0.4 mile toward Railroad Station at Eastville.

ROUTE 35

Petersburg to Courtland, thence west along Route 12 approximately 2.18 miles, thence south 2.0 miles toward Boykins.

351—Waverly to intersection Route 35 near Homeville, thence north along Route 35 to Lambs, thence to Sussex C. H.

ROUTE 36

Alexandria, Fairfax, thence along Route 21 about 1 mile, Aldie, thence along Route 32 to Middleburg, Upperville, Boyce, Winchester, Gore, West Virginia line.

ROUTE 37

Westland, Kilmarnock, Lancaster, Totusky Bridge, thence along Route 13 to Warsaw, Montross, King George, Fredericksburg, Stevensburg, Culpeper, Sperryville, thence along Route 21 to Massie's Corner, Washington, VIRGINIA, Front Royal, Armel, Winchester, Berryville, Gaylord, to the West Virginia line.

371—Near Templeman's Cross Roads to Heathsville and Reedsville.

372—Approximately 6.8 miles east of King George county line, in Westmoreland county to Wakefield, the birthplace of Washington.

373—Riverton to Strasburg.

374—15 miles east of Orange, via Rhoadesville to Orange.

375—Comorn to Dahlgren.

376—Main street Berryville, between Routes 37 and 251.

ROUTE 38

Mathews Court House to 4.8 miles west, and from 6.01 miles east of Cooks Corner to Cooks Corner, thence along Route 30 to Saluda, Bray's Fork, thence along Route 13 to Tappahannock, Fredericksburg, Falmouth, 9 miles west, and from 5.0 miles east of Route 32 to intersect Route 32 about 9 miles south of Warrenton.

ROUTE 39

Old Point, Hampton, Newport News, Williamsburg, Providence Forge, point near Mountcastle, Richmond, Mineral, Louisa, Trevillians, Cobham, Charlottesvill, Afton, Waynesboro, Staunton, Churchville, Monterey,

thence south via Vanderpool Gap, Mill Gap to the West Virginia line near Frost.

391—Lee Hall, Yorktown, 15.35 miles toward Hampton.

392—Williamsburg to Jamestown, and from 1.5 miles north Wakefield to Wakefield.

393—Bottoms' Bridge to 2.0 miles east of New Kent C. H., and from Intersection Route 30 along 14th street, West Point and toward the waterfront for half a mile.

394—Phoebus to Buckroe Beach.

395—Monterey, north 7 miles toward Franklin, W. Va.

396—See 251.

397—Intersection Route 39 about 1 mile west of Lee Hall to intersect Route 391 near Lebanon Church.

ROUTE 40

Portsmouth via Deep Creek, to North Carolina line.

ROUTE 41

2.0 miles east of Charles City via Charles City, Richmond, 7.5 miles west of W. C. L. of Richmond (4.2 miles east of Henrico-Goochland county line) Oilville, Hadensville, Zion, thence west 1.0 miles toward Keswick.
